

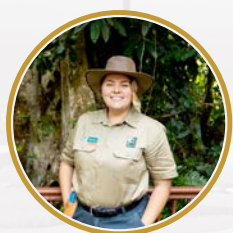


Skyrail Rangers



To enhance your experience and unlock the secrets of the Wet Tropics World Heritage-listed rainforest, we offer personalised guided tours with dedicated Skeyrail Rangers. Available for groups, we offer you the Skeyrail Interpretive Ranger Option (IRO).

Upon arrival, your group will be welcomed by a knowledgeable Skeyrail Ranger, who will accompany them throughout their entire one-way journey. (We recommend a ratio of one ranger for every 20 participants).



Disembark at Red Peak Station and traverse a universally accessible boardwalk set amidst the forest floor. Here, you can learn about the unique flora and fauna of the tropical rainforest in the Rainforest Discovery Zone. At Barron Falls Station, we'll introduce you to the area's incredible history and culture, and you'll overlook the Barron Gorge and Barron Falls / DinDin. Enjoy the spectacular views from The Edge Lookout and visit the Rainforest Interpretation Centre to learn more about this unique and fragile ecosystem.

The Skeyrail Rangers will share their engaging stories, enriching the experience with their knowledge and passion of this ancient environment. Available to answer all of your questions and provide a deeper, more hands-on rainforest experience.

Skyrail Rainforest Cableway in Cairns, Queensland, Australia, is a world first tourist attraction designed with an environmental conservation concept. Offering a truly unique perspective above the ancient canopy and deep into the World Heritage listed Wet Tropics rainforest.

After undergoing a decade-long benchmarking test and certification program, Skyrail became the first in the Pacific region to receive the EarthCheck Platinum Certification. It is the only cableway in the world to have achieved this level of certification. Now honoured as an EarthCheck Certified Master, the highest available accolade, demonstrating more than 20 years of commitment to the highest standards of environmental care and making social contributions.



As one of the earliest operators to receive certification under the Advanced Ecotourism National Accreditation program by Ecotourism Australia, Skyrail has demonstrated a 20 year and beyond commitment to ecologically sustainable tourism, which fosters environmental and cultural understanding, appreciation and conservation.



The Climate Action Certification, which focuses on reducing carbon dioxide emissions, acknowledges products that are dedicated to sustainable operations with climate change awareness. Skyrail has been recognised as a Climate Action Innovator for its proactive efforts in reducing emissions.
